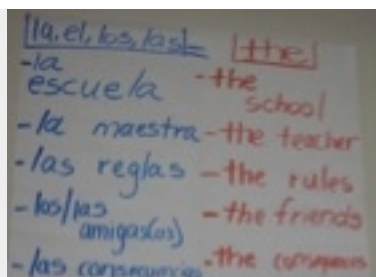

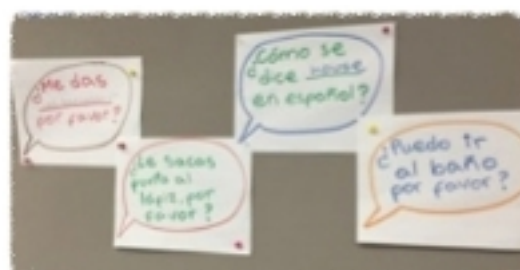
*authentic Spanish-language reading material?*
